TAX COLLECTOR REMINDS PROPERTY OWNERS TO SIGN UP FOR eBILLING

San Bernardino, CA — San Bernardino County Tax Collector Larry Walker is reminding taxpayers about the eBill delivery initiative now available to property owners in San Bernardino County. This initiative enables property owners to receive their property tax bills electronically by signing up on the website, www.MyTaxCollector.com.

"My office is committed to providing excellent customer service to the property owners in San Bernardino County and to identify opportunities to reduce costs without impacting our level of service," Walker said. "Electronic property tax bills provide a significant opportunity to reduce costs, and I invite property owners to join me in enrolling to receive their bill electronically."

Electronic delivery of tax bills will begin with the 2010 Annual Secured Property Tax Bills and will be delivered in the Fall of this year. Savings are estimated at 58 cents for each bill delivered electronically, based on postage costs as well as the cost of paper and envelopes.

There is still time for property owners to enroll and receive their 2010 bill electronically. Enrollments that are completed by September 1, 2010 will be processed prior to generating the annual bills.
